



### Regional shares of top 30 port volumes: 2021 vs. 2016







### COVID-19: Stringency Index



The stringency index is a composite measure based on nine response indicators including school closures, workplace closures, and travel bans, rescaled to a value from 0 to 100 (100 = strictest).








# Supply chain problems in 2022?

US corporate expectations of when supply chains disruptions will end




Euro area firms with production constraints from material and equipment shortages





# All categories of services trade increasing in Q2-Q4 2021















# Ukraine and Russia not major trade partners
